live unstably housed, but of those who die that way.

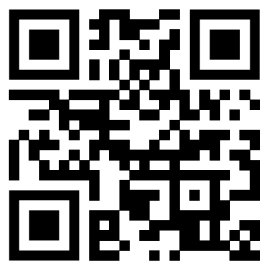
Generous blanket makers (knitting, crocheting or quilting) will create a special gift for a total stranger experiencing homelessness. We would like twin and full sized blankets.
