This year, the installation will grace the lawn at **Bannock Street** in Denver, Colorado by the **City/County Building** from **1 PM until 6 PM**.

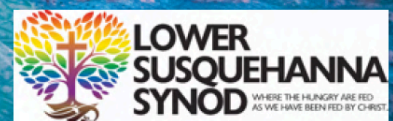
